What You Need:

Maze Paper Crayons
Finger Paint Pencil

Directions:

Marker

- 1. As the kids come into your area, make each of them a paper bag with their name on it. Set the bags aside.
- 2. Give each child a maze paper to start on. They can do the maze and color the people on the paper. While you pass the paper out make sure to tell them that Jesus wanted the little kids to come to him.
- 3. As they are coloring have the kids come over to you one at a time to paint on the paper that says, "Jesus loves kids."
- 4. Have each child use their finger to make finger print people. They can make Jesus and a few children
- 5. One finger print is for the body, one is for the head, and two prints for their legs and arms.
- 6. Have them go back to the maze picture while the paint is drying.
- 7. When the paint has dried have them add faces and hair to their finger print people.
- 8. When they are finished talk to them about how Jesus loves kids and wants to help them.
- 9. Make a sack for each child with their name on it. Place their project, the parent information sheet (what we learned today) and one piece of candy in their sack.


